CUT TO:

PHILLIP

hush on you playing Santa given the
recent publicity around you. My
vendors don't need the controversy.

COLIN

Understood.

They walk around the newly created snow and workshop.

The conversation moves on to the Santa time conduct while
playing the role.

Phil is specific about all the procedures. Santa time.
Break time. Rules of the beard.

Phil proudly looks at the display and throne for Santa.
proud of his accomplishments, he sighs.

PHILLIP

Praise Jesus. Praise him good.

CUT TO:

24 INT. MALL - PHILLIPS OFFICE - EVENING

There is a circle of chairs and seven worshippers along with Phil leading the group in an opening prayer. They all hold hands except for Colin. He keeps his eyes open while everyone else closes their eyes, bow their heads and pray hard.

When the prayer gets more vigorous and halty, some in the group stand up and start convulsing and speaking in tongues. Colin is frightened and intrigued by this.

- an older white guy interprets his understanding of the verse they are studying which sounds very much like a kkk speech.

- a young woman plays the guitar and sings a very monotonous song worshipping the lord.
